QUALIFICATIONS:

Qualifications of a Board member consist of the following:

- A legal domiciliary of the CNMI and a U.S. Citizen.
- Of legal adult voting age within the CNMI. In this particular vacancy, the adult must be a registered voter at their respective islands; and
- A demonstrated capacity for representing the CNMI's career and technical training fields relative to meeting the overall purpose of NMTech.

No person may become a Trustee while a CNMI government or NMTech employee, or until one year after the conclusion of CNMI government or NMTech employment.

POWERS OF NMTECH BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

The Board of Trustees is the governing body of the Northern Marianas Technical Institute. It derives its power from and exists under Public Law 20-92. The Board has the power and responsibility to discharge any duty imposed by law upon it or upon the Institute, and will execute powers delegated by law to it or to the Institute.
